

FLORIDA PALM TRIP January 11 to 18, 2018

Welcome to “The World’s Most Famous Beach!” Leave Midwest winters behind and head with us to Daytona Beach. We travel south through Southern Illinois, across Kentucky and the Volunteer State, Tennessee. Overnighting in Georgia, our group enters the Sunshine State, crosses the Suwannee River and we soon arrive at Daytona Beach.

Our group enjoys a beachfront hotel location for five nights on the Atlantic Ocean. After all—what’s the point if you are not right on the beach?

Day trips head in different directions—each offering a different view of the central Florida Atlantic Coast with our group and tour escort. We visit and pray at Florida’s first mission, the Mission Nombre de Dios. We celebrate Mass at this most important location where Catholic Mass was first offered in the New World. The mission also is home to the Shrine of Our Lady of LaLeche, dedicated to all mothers. St Augustine’s St. George Street offers opportunities to explore the city’s historic district. Shops and eateries line this open-air pedestrian-only street.

Another day takes our group south to Cape Canaveral, home of the Kennedy Space Center. From here many departed on ventures to land a man on the moon.

No visit to this region would be complete without a visit to the most famous central Florida shrine. Well, it's a shrine of a different sense—Walt Disney World. We'll have the day to visit Disney's Epcot Center®. Guests have the option to visit one of other Disney theme parks: Magic Kingdom, Hollywood Studios or Disney's Animal Kingdom. All guests receive a one-day one-park ticket; the choice is yours. We'll park at Disney's Epcot Center®; guests opting for other Disney parks may use Disney's complimentary transportation buses.

There is one free day to spend as you wish; combing the beach, going deep sea fishing, or relaxing at our ocean front hotel.

From our beachfront hotel located on the beach at Daytona Beach, Florida, our trip takes day trips to various places of historic, religious and scenic interests. As in all Golden Frontier trips, the use of a base hotel enhances your enjoyment of the trip. The base hotel affords the opportunity to sightsee daily without the need to constantly pack and unpack. There is a complete itinerary of available activities. For those who do not wish to participate in that day's program, there is the freedom to pursue other activities or interests.



Also part of our trip is a day visit to the Kennedy Space Center including the bus tour that takes us to restricted areas where America launched flights to the moon. Exhibits in the Visitor Center round out the visit.



One evening features Daytona's only dinner show spectacular. We'll enjoy a sumptuous Polynesian dinner buffet before the dinner show begins. Polynesian dancers show traditional dances from Tahiti, Samoa Figi and other South Sea Islands. Warrior and fire knife dancers complete the performance cast with a show that will make you feel like you are in Polynesia. It's the Ohana Luau spectacular that you won't forget.

One question remains: how many Midwestern snow and ice storms will it take to convince you to join us on this trip to the "World's Most Famous Beach"?

A \$100.00 registration fee must be paid with the application. Three people registering together and sharing a two bedded room receive a \$15.00 discount per person. Single accommodations are available for an additional \$255.00 per person. Optional oceanfront rooms are available. Balance of fee is required 40 days prior to the departure date. Registrations after this date require payment in full at time of registration. You will receive a bill for final payment. *2019 trip price may be adjusted after 7/1/2018.

Note: Parking your car during the trip at the point of pickup is at the sole discretion of the motel. Neither Golden Frontier nor the motel assume any risk for your parked car. Minimum groups of twenty from one area may request a pickup and return at their choice location at no additional cost.

CASUAL CLOTHING is always acceptable. No formal or dressy wear is necessary on this trip. Jackets and sweaters that can be layered for cooler mornings are good. A small travel umbrella or rain gear will help for brief unexpected showers. No show shovels are required on this trip (at least in Florida)!

THE WEATHER is normally comfortable. This time of year, the Daytona Beach resort area should be a pleasant place to visit and delightful compared to the snowy and cold Midwest. January temperatures range from 50's overnight to low 70's during the day.

LUGGAGE is limited to one bag per person. You may also bring a small carry-on bag which you can place in the overhead rack of the coach. Golden Frontier cannot be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged articles.

PURPOSE. Golden Frontier is sponsored by Catholic Shrine Pilgrimage, Inc., non-profit religious organization. These programs are arranged to give the people of this area an opportunity to visit historic shrines of North America amid friendly companionship. These trips are arranged for adults, with seniors in mind. A priest chaplain normally accompanies each trip.

RESPONSIBILITY. This tour is under the operation of Golden Frontier who shall be responsible for supplying services and accommodations as outlined in this brochure, except as to the extent such cannot be supplied due to delays or causes beyond the control of Golden Frontier. In the absence of negligence on the part of the tour operator, the tour member waives any claim against Golden Frontier from any damage, loss of property, injury, death, due to any act of negligence of any hotel or person rendering any services or accommodations. Golden Frontier reserves the right to make equal substitutions if the need arises. Golden Frontier reserves the right to cancel any trip due to adverse weather conditions or lack of sufficient reservations. In this event a full refund of all tour member's payments made will be given. Participants agree to the use of their photo or image which may be taken on this trip in future Golden Frontier publications and presentations without compensation by or claim to CSP.

SPECIAL DIETS can normally be accommodated with adequate advance notice. Please notify our office of any special dietary needs, and attach written explanation to application

OPTIONAL TRIP CANCELLATION AND BAGGAGE INSURANCE is available for those who desire. Insurance can cover cancellation of your reservation prior to departure, leaving the tour after departure, baggage loss, accidents, and some medical coverages. A brochure and application for insurance will be sent to all applicants or is available by calling the Golden Frontier office.

REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS must be in writing and are considered on the day received. Guests cancelling 60 or more days prior to departure receive a refund of the monies paid. Guests cancelling 59 to 40 days prior to departure forfeit the registration fee. Guests cancelling 40 days or less prior to departure and not providing a replacement traveler, no shows, or guests leaving the tour after departure receive a refund of only those fees recoverable by Golden Frontier from various suppliers. Guests cancelling 60 days or less prior to departure and providing a replacement traveler receive a refund of fees paid. Due to reservation and advance purchase requirements for attractions and meals, there are no refunds on unused tour features.

ROOM ARRANGEMENTS are normally two people sharing a room. Singles may sign up and travel at the double rate if you agree to Golden Frontier attempting to find a room mate (same gender) to share. If we do not find a room mate to share, you still travel at the double rate. If you do not wish to share a room, single accommodations are available. Unless single rate is requested accommodations will be shared. A special room rate for three can be arranged with discount. Triples should mail applications in the same envelope. Triples share standard two bedded room without added roll away bed.
